
1 The context – Milan

Summary statistics

- Population: about 1,400,000 inhabitants; + 3.5% 2010 vs 2016
- Metropolitan area + 3,200,000 inhabitants (one of the most densely populated areas in Europe); + 1,9% 2010 vs 2016
- Under 14: 13.8%; between 15 and 64: 63.8%, over 65: 22.5%;
- Foreigners: 8%, more numerous among young people (about 25%).

Economy and labour

- Milan produces about 12% of the national GDP (ref. 2016)
- GDP per capita: 46,000 euros (average Italy 25,000);
- 300.000 companies (50% services, 25% trade); double national average
- Vocations: Agri-food, finance, manufacturing, life sciences, cultural and creative industries;
- Tourists 12 million in 2017 (vs. 5 million in 2000)
- 4th city in EU/15th in the world Real Estate Investments
- Employed 70.7% in 2016 (+ 12% compared to the Italian average);

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La Scuola dei Quartieri ("the School of the Suburbs") is a project realized with the support of the Multi-fund National **Operational Program Metropolitan Cities 2014-2020 (PON** METRO).

PON Metro gave the opportunity to the Municipality of Milan, with approximately EUR 4 Million, to answer locally to the challenge of re-design and co-design new services in decayed areas with the goal of improving living conditions and social inclusion.

LA SCUOLA DEI QUARTIERI IS A PROJECT OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MILAN

The School has two objectives:

> to give birth to projects and services, designed and implemented by the citizens, to improve the life of the suburbs

> To change the peripheries of the city, enhancing the energy, the creativity and the resourcefulness of the inhabitants













WHY A "SCHOOL"?

BECAUSE KNOWLEDGE IS THE MOST IMPORTANT SOCIAL LIFT

Scuola dei Quartieri is inspired by the tradition of the **Civic Schools of Milan**

Since the early 1800s, in times of great change, the municipality has invested in **education** and **training** to allow citizens to work, to be autonomous and to participate in the life of the community

Today the competence of the future is **knowing how to design**











WHY "OF THE SUBURBS"?

There is no age limit and no academic title is required to access

It has no classrooms and takes place in the actual places where people live and work: in the social spaces, in public places, in offices, in the back rooms...


TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS OF PEOPLE WHO WANT TO DELIVER SOMETHING NEW FOR THE SUBURB: A PROJECT , A SERVICE OR A SOCIAL ENTERPRISE

The activities of the School are designed for:

1. Those who want to commit and are seeking for the right idea

2. Those who have an idea but do not know where to start

3. Those who have a project ready to start and want to take action implementing it





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1. THOSE WHO SEEK FOR THE RIGHT IDEA

... and want to commit for their community, can participate in open meetings and workshops to discuss the problems, the characteristics and vocations of the suburb

What was there and what is there now?

What is missing and what could be there?

How transforming a problem turning it into an opportunity?













2. THOSE WHO HAVE AN IDEA

... or even an intuition or a desire and don't know even where to start, can participate in the basic laboratories to learn how to design

How is a "good idea" made?

How to create a "social impact" enterprise?

Who can help me?











3. THOSE WHO HAVE A PROJECT READY TO START

... and want to take action, can follow a free 10-week advanced training course held by experts in social entrepreneurship

How to move from theory into practice?

What are the necessary tools?

How is a social "business plan" made?

Where to find the money to start?












WHAT HAPPENS **AFTER THE TRAINING?**

At the end of the advanced training course , the most deserving participants can be selected to receive:

> a "project grant" up to a maximum of € 25,000 to co-finance the first year of activity

> customized advisory service in all phases, from the start to the conclusion

All participants will receive a certificate stating the skills learned, and receive support to continue the activity













A SCHOOL MADE BY THOSE WHO LIVE AND WORK IN THE SUBURBS

The Municipalities , associations , committees , artisans, shop-keepers and active citizens can collaborate with the School in many ways:

- > pointing out needs, experiences, stories or activities in progress
- > hosting lectures, workshops or meetings in their own premises
- > becoming supporters or teachers
- > helping new projects to start and grow over time











HOW TO PARTICIPATE?

The **public** presentations and discussion **meetings** in the suburbs are open access. *It is possible to participate alone or in group.*

The basic laboratories to learn how to plan are accessible on reservation. You can also participate alone, and probably meet fellow travelers.

To participate in the **advanced training courses** lasting 10 weeks, you must be a group (minimum 2 people), have a project idea and **pass a selection**.

The Municipality of Milan will publish a call for tenders every 6 months

To receive a **project grant** up to for 25,000 euros and **support services**, you need to follow the entire advanced training path and have a useful, feasible and concrete project besides being motivated and ready to start













SOME NUMBERS

60 groups will participate in the advanced training and can receive contributions

40 new organizations are about to be born, financed and accompanied

WHERE ARE WE NOW?

During the first months of activity, the school has already involved **+ 800** people


The **first call for proposals** (June - September 2019) selected the first 20 ideas.

20 proposing **groups** are attending advanced training. The best projects will be financed and will start in **February 2020**

In **november 2019** the second cycle of meetings and workshops will start.
